

Competitive scholarships for students who have passed Reading, Writing and Mathematics WASL assessments:

**EASTERN WASHINGTON UNIVERSITY** offers the Academic Achievement Scholarship. The selection is based on academic performance, SAT/ACT scores, and other information presented in the application.

Applicants who took the 10th-grade Washington Assessment of Student Learning (WASL) must have passed the Math, Reading, and Writing sections to be eligible for consideration. Students who wish to be considered for the scholarship must submit a completed application by February 1.

**UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON.** Each year about 300 resident freshmen are selected to receive the Undergraduate Scholar Award. Selection is based on academic performance, SAT/ACT scores, and other information presented in the admission application. Students who wish to be considered for these scholarships must submit a completed admission application by December 1. Applicants who took the 10th-grade Washington Assessment of Student Learning (WASL) must have passed the Math, Reading, and Writing sections to be eligible for consideration and will be asked to report their WASL scores on the admission application.

**THE EVERGREEN STATE COLLEGE.** Each year TESC awards up to 54 Regional High School Counselor Awards based on counselor recommendations and passage of the Math, Reading, and Writing sections of the 10th-grade Washington Assessment of Student Learning (WASL).

**WASHINGTON STATE UNIVERSITY** offers the Glenn Terrell Presidential Scholarship. The selection is based on academic performance, SAT/ACT scores, and other information presented in the application.

Applicants who took the 10th-grade Washington Assessment of Student Learning (WASL) must have passed the Math, Reading, and Writing sections to be eligible for consideration. Students who wish to be considered for the scholarship must be offered admission and submit a completed scholarship application by January 31.

**WESTERN WASHINGTON UNIVERSITY** offers the Washington Public High School Achievement Scholarship to 25 incoming freshmen from Washington public high schools. Eligibility requirements include outstanding achievement throughout high school; a rigorous high school curriculum including 4 or more units of math and 4 or more units of science; and achieving a passing level on the Math, Reading, and Writing sections of the 10th-grade WASL.

**CENTRAL WASHINGTON UNIVERSITY** offers the President's Waiver Scholarship. The selection is based on academic performance, SAT/ACT scores, and other information presented in the application. Applicants who took the 10th-grade Washington Assessment of Student Learning (WASL) must have passed the Math, Reading, and Writing sections to be eligible for consideration. Students who wish to be considered for the scholarship must be admitted to the University by February 1.
